Thank you for the seamless way in which you've worked with us on this amongst many other things. It's certainly been a wet week but

that hasn't stopped us in our tracks. There is great learning happening right

across our school in so many different ways as your children settle in their classes and embrace the many other opportunities we have on offer. It was delightful to share in the musical magic of guitar lessons yesterday as our budding musicians are nurtured and encouraged.





COVID Safe Update

Yesterday the Premier and Minister for Education

announced changes to school settings for the remainder of the term. These updated settings were developed in close consultation with NSW Health and key stakeholders to ensure we continue to keep our schools open for learning, while keeping up with changing community settings. The updated settings include:

- Continued use of rapid antigen tests (RATs) for twice-weekly testing of students and staff until Friday 25 February. From Monday 28 February, we will move to symptomatic testing. Tests are to be used at your discretion such as if your child is symptomatic or there are cases in their class. Our school will provide each student and staff member with 8 tests per student. Beyond that, students and staff can access PCR tests or buy their own rapid antigen tests as these are now freely available and accessible in the community.
- Masks will continue to be required indoors for all school staff, volunteers and visitors including parents and carers in primary schools until Friday 4 March. From Monday 7 March, masks will no longer be mandatory for all staff. However, those who wish to continue to use them will be supported to do so.
- From Monday 28 February, visitors can be allowed back on school sites regardless of their vaccination status. We will
 review organisation such as pick up and drop off arrangements, parent-teacher meetings and other events over the
 next week and update you when we have new plans in place. We ask that everyone continues with our current
 routines for next week so that we have time to communicate new routines before we change them.

• As of Monday 28 February, students will no longer be required to be kept in year groups or other cohorts. As a result, we are reviewing our staggered start and finish times. We'll provide more information on this over the next week.

Our school will continue to ensure our layered COVID-smart measures are in place, including vaccinations, maximising natural ventilation in learning spaces, continued good hand hygiene practices and enhanced cleaning.

Parent Information Evenings

Thank you to all members of the community who have been able to join us via Zoom for this week's Parent Information evenings. It has been brilliant to have so many parents involved and the teachers have enjoyed connecting with you and sharing their learning plans for the year. The next major meetings scheduled regarding student progress are the student/parent/teacher learning conferences later this term. Notes regarding these interviews will be sent home soon. Teachers are always happy to meet to discuss student learning so if you would like to chat with your child's teacher regarding any aspect of your child's education please don't hesitate to make an appointment.

Teacher Release


From time to time you will notice that your child's teacher is not on class with them for the day. There are a number of reasons (in additional to illness) why this could be the case. Teachers might be required to do additional planning for the class or a specific student, they may be working on a whole school program that benefits all children across the school or they may be involved in planned professional learning programs to enhance knowledge and teaching practice. Each class works with our team of 'release' teachers for two hours during the week to participate in dedicated programs such as personal development, dance, Italian and Japanese. Rest assured when your child's teacher is 'off class' they thoroughly plan lessons for the day and communicate key information about their students to the replacement teacher. At Woollahra we also make every effort to ensure we have a consistent casual workforce to promote stability and on-going learning if your child's teacher needs to be away.

Safety for all is a high priority across the school and as a result we have strong Work, Health and Safety processes and a tight emergency plan. Last week we held our first evacuation drill for the year. We are proud to say we had all students and adults safely off site in Chiswick Gardens in a short amount of time. 
Supervision Before and After School

The safety of all of our students is paramount at all times. This includes before and after school. Please be reminded that teacher supervision in the playground starts at 8.30am each morning. No child is permitted to be at school before this time unless they are enrolled in a supervised before school activity. We have had a number of children arriving at school early and remaining unsupervised in the playground. Helping Hands run an excellent before school care program in Block E from 7.00am each morning if you need to drop your children early. We ask that you make use of this service if need be. In the afternoons we ask that all children leave the playground at 3.00pm and do not remain to play unsupervised. Helping Hands' after care service runs from 3.00pm until 6.00pm.

School Photos

Class, Individual, School Leaders and School House Captains photographs will take place on Friday 11 March 2022.

We ask that students wear their correct summer uniform including black shoes, navy socks and blue hair accessories. Please do not include any other payments with your photograph envelope, these envelopes are not opened by the school and are given directly to the photographer.

Text Books

Most students have now paid for their text books online. If you have not already done so please refer to last week's information on how to do this. LJ Harper are currently updating us daily with reports on books paid for overnight and we will issue the text books from the office.

Osborne Lane Pick Up

We are continually working to ensure efficient and safe pick up procedures for your children. Of significant concern are the safety issues at the gate on Osborne Lane. This gate is not to be used as a pedestrian entry and exit due to the safety concerns with traffic and visibility. Please ensure you adhere to the following procedures:

- ALL pedestrians to use the Forth Street gates. Crossing the road at the Osborne gate is not safe with so many cars coming through. We appreciate your cooperation with this.
- Ensure you have talked to your children and reminded them to be lined up on the soccer field near the gate as soon as they leave class at 3pm. The teachers are also working on this to make sure your children are at the gate as soon as you pull up.
- Please do not park in the lane and get out of your car. This causes congestion problems in the lane and makes it unsafe.
- We are able to fit two cars at the gate if the first car moves up as far as possible. This way two children can be picked up at once allowing the line to move faster.
- Please ensure you do not queue along Edgecliff Road waiting to turn into Osborne Lane. If you are unable to turn into the lane, please drive around the block and come back.

Traffic Safety – Important Reminders

To help schools keep the school zone safer for all pedestrians and drivers there are seven new traffic offences with new fines. None of the seven offences attract demerit points when committed elsewhere on the road but now in a school zone they each come with two points. The changes are:

- Stopping in intersection Under the changes if a driver commits this offence in a school zone they will receive a
 penalty of \$439 and 2 demerit points.
- Stop within 20m of intersection (traffic lights) Under the changes if a driver commits this offence in a school zone they will receive a penalty of \$439 and 2 demerit points.
- Stop within 10m of intersection (no traffic lights) Under the changes if a driver commits this offence in a school zone they will receive a penalty of \$439 and 2 demerit points.
- Stop near bicycle crossing lights Under the changes if a driver commits this offence in a school zone they will receive a penalty of \$439 and 2 demerit points.
- Obstruct access to ramp/path/passageway Under the changes if a driver commits this offence in a school zone they will receive a penalty of \$330 and 2 demerit points.
- Not parallel park in the direction of travel Under the changes if a driver commits this offence in a school zone they will receive a \$330 fine and 2 demerit points.
- Parallel park close to dividing line Under the changes if a driver commits this offence in a school zone they will receive a \$330 fine and 2 demerit points.

High School Applications for Year 6 Students – entry into Year 7 2023

It is now time for parents of Year 6 students to begin the process of completing and submitting applications for high school placement in 2021. Please note the following information:

- Expression of interest application forms have been sent home today
- Each form indicates your designated local high school based on your address. You will have the option to apply for your
 local high school, apply for a non-local placement or indicate that you do not require a placement for your child in a
 NSW government school in 2023. A form needs to be returned for every child regardless of the option you select.
- If you need advice about your options or about applying for a non-local placement, do not hesitate to contact the school to speak to Ms Hayward, Mrs Fetherston, Mrs Warhurst, Miss Petriella or Ms Molloy. We are happy to assist and advise.
- All forms need to be returned to your child's class teacher **NO LATER than Thursday 10 March** to ensure the school has enough time to process them before we are required to submit them to the high schools. We ask that you complete the forms as early as possible so that we are able to contact you if there are any omissions or errors.


